



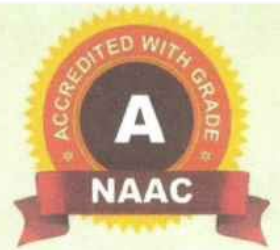

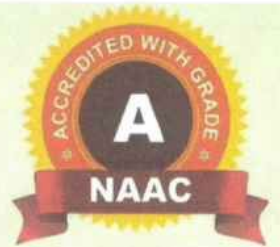

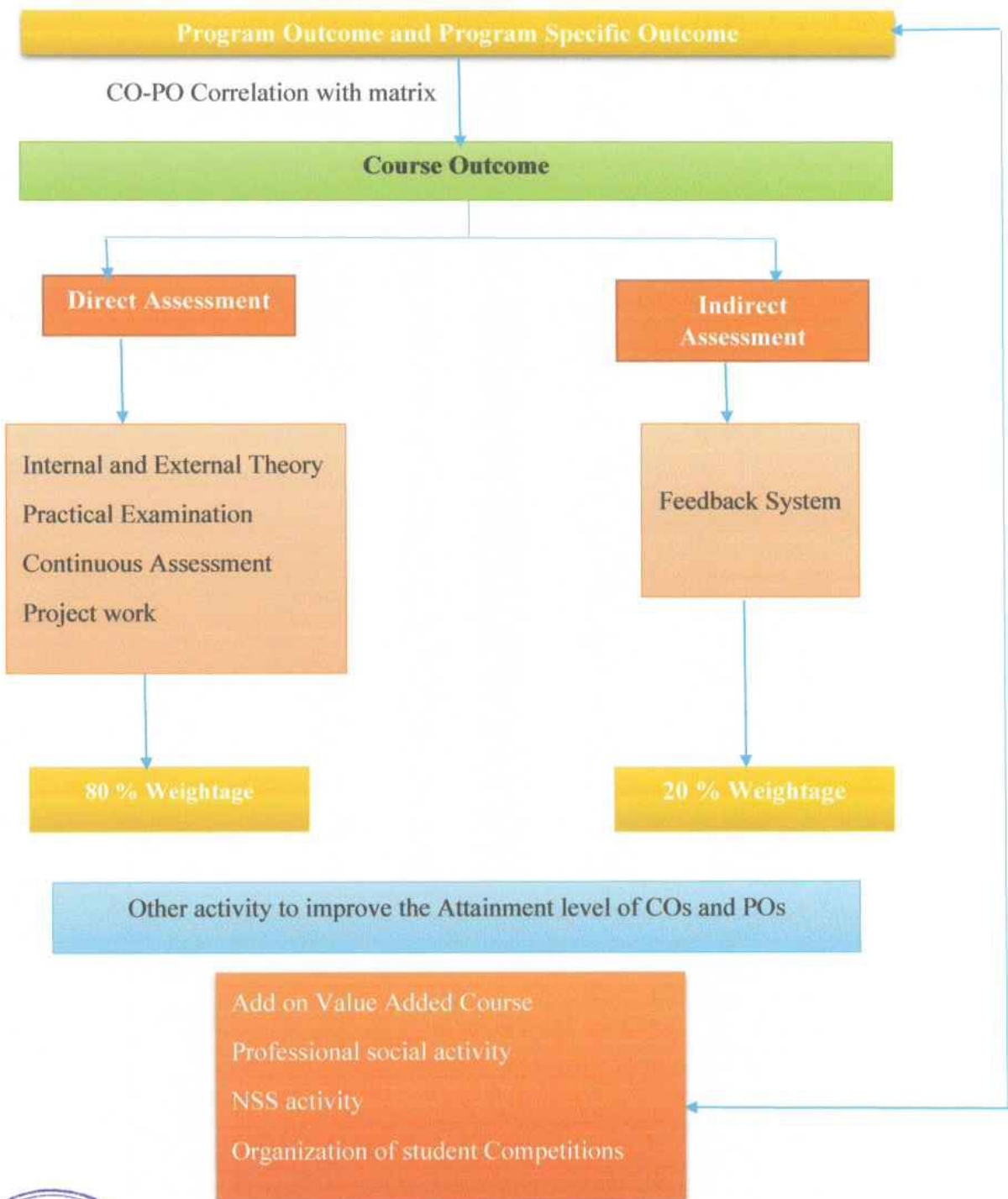

1	Written Sessional Examination	4 times in a year for semester pattern (2 Sessional exam per Semester)	Examinations provide direct evidence of student academic achievement and can be more objective, valid and reliable. A written examination where the students have not seen the examination questions prior to appearing the exam. The examinations are made up of one or more descriptive questions or combination of short questions, problem solving questions. There is a time restriction for completion of the exam. The outcomes measured by the examinations are identical to the program's student learning outcomes and the examination questions will assess both course and program outcome. With some creativity, questions can also be written to cover broader POs without losing their validity for course evaluation.	All program outcomes

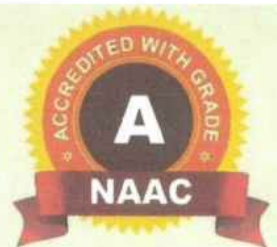
