- Pictures/ graphics should be clearly labelled & described with correct grammar
- Use adequate contrast for better visualization.
- Remember that simpler posters are always more attractive and easier to read.
- Do not use symbols & special characters in file names when saving documents.
- Time for Presentation will be 5 minutes including the questionnaire.
